# Enrollment Process

- ❖ Meet prerequisite requirements as outlined in the SHS Curriculum Guide.
- ❖ Meet the college readiness standards on the Texas Success Initiative (TSI)
- ❖ TSI pre-assessment is required before the test date.
  - April 6th - Juniors testing
  - April 12th - dual students in 9th & 10th grades
    - Cost for 9th & 10th graders: \$30
    - Due before the test date.
- ❖ Exemption standards for the TSI
  - SAT - Math + Reading =1070, with at least a 500 for reading and math
  - or ACT - composite of 23, with at least a 19 for reading and math
- ❖ Complete an application on [www.rangercollege.edu](http://www.rangercollege.edu).
- ❖ Return a signed parent permission form to the counselors.
- ❖ SHS will send a transcript and test scores to Ranger.

# Paying for Dual

## **Payment due by 10 days before classes begin in August and in January**

You can choose to pay ½ of the tuition now and half midway through the semester, but you need to mark your calendar to pay the second half.

### ❖ **Tuition per semester**

- > 3 hour course - \$240
- > 4 hour course - \$320
- > Cosmetology \$250 per semester

### ❖ **How to pay:**

- > A check or money order should be made payable to Ranger College and have the student's full name written in the "Memo" section.
- > Call the Ranger Bursar office at 254-647-3234 ext. 214 to make the payment with a debit or credit card.
- > Use **Campus Connect** (available in January) to pay with debit or credit card.
  - **\*\*This account is a good way to check if your student has been registered for their classes.**
  - Campus Connect - Go to [www.rangercollege.edu](http://www.rangercollege.edu) , then find 'campus connect' in the list on the right. Once on the Campus Connect page, select 'Campus Connect for Students' under Off Campus.
    - Username – entire social security number
    - Password – 8 digit birthdate
  - Campus Connect features – Bill pay, unofficial transcript (good to take with you on a campus visit), current enrollment, and grades

### ❖ **Student Privacy**

- Dual credit students have the same privacy rights as adult college students.
- SHS and Ranger College teachers do not have the right to discuss your student's grades.

### ❖ **Access to Grades**

- You can ask your student to log into their Blackboard account for current grades.
- Campus Connect includes completed course grades only.

# Drop Rule & 3-Peat Rule

- Limits on Dropped Courses & Withdraws
  - This policy is to help students stay on course for graduation with minimal cost for the student.
  - **Section Bill 2183, 80th Legislature; THECB Regulations, Chapter 4, Section 4.10(a) states, ....an institution of higher education may not permit an undergraduate student a total of more than six dropped courses.**
  - **Applies to state colleges and universities and excludes courses taken in high school.**
- 3 - Peat Rule
  - This rule was passed by the State to discourage students from repeating courses unnecessarily.
  - **If a student attempts the same course for a third time, they could be charged tuition not exceeding that of out-of-state tuition rates for that course. This provision is described in the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board Rules (Chapter 13, Subchapter B, §13.25).**
